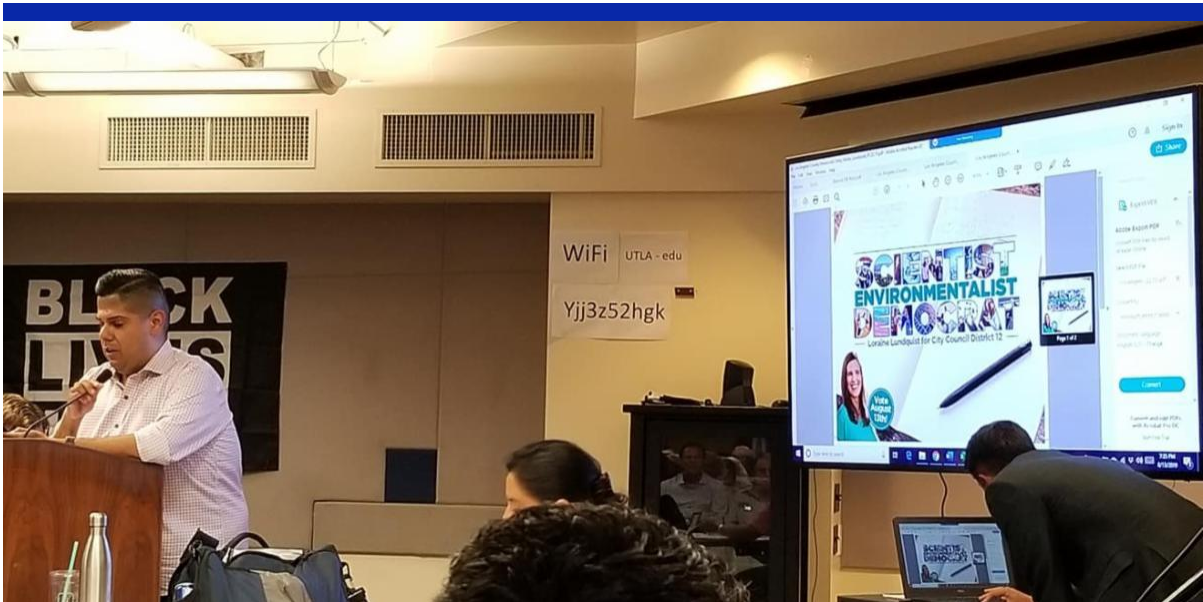

After Census 2020, California will go through the redistricting process, which involves redrawing political districts at the federal, state, and local levels. This process is important because it will help our communities

have a fair opportunity to representatives who will be responsive to our communities' needs.

We need to ensure that Commission members truly reflect the demographic and geographic diversity of our state. There is a wealth of skill and talent to share with the Commission, and they are important for a line-drawing process that strengthens the representation of all of our communities.

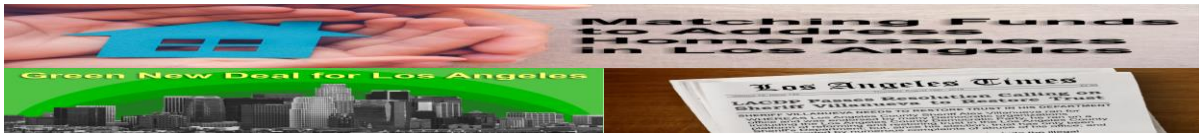
