Margarita Fernandez spoke on the upcoming CA redistricting. The California State Auditor's Office is currently accepting applications for the 2020 Redistricting Commission at <http://shapecaliforniasfuture.auditor.ca.gov>. Eligible California citizens are encouraged to apply.

2020 Census:
Why it Matters, and What You Can Do

California is facing the greatest barriers in the nation for the 2020 Census.

The Census isn't just about a count, it is about fair representation. It's your civic duty. It's about redistricting. It's about resources. It's about our communities.

How is the Census data used?

The data collected is used to advocate for more resources for communities, to ensure public safety and plan new schools and hospitals. As well as deciding where to open businesses, which create jobs.

By law, the U.S. Census Bureau cannot share the state with immigration or law enforcement agencies or allow it to determine eligibility for government benefits.

Join efforts in your community:

There are many local, statewide and national groups, as well as state-funded contractors, already planning and organizing in California. They can provide an overview of what's being done and next steps – and are a great place to get involved.

The California Democratic Party Delegation will send a total of 495 delegates and 35 alternates to the Democratic National Convention in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. The total delegation will be comprised of 416 Pledged Delegates, 35 Alternates, and 79 Unpledged Delegates.
